Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting 2018

The Chair was authorised to sign the minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on the 14th May 2018, as a true record.

Public Participation

- **Culgaith Village Hall Trustees.** A representative of the Culgaith Village Hall (Victoria Institute) raised the issue of the Village Hall Trustees. It being explained that a village hall charity will normally have two sets of trustees, Managing Trustees and Holding or Custodian Trustees.

The Holding (Custodian) Trustees hold the land or property on behalf of the Charity. Their sole function is to hold the title to the property. They should not be involved with the management of the property, this being the responsibility of the Managing Trustees.

Holding Trustees can change if they are individuals. There is an argument for the Holding Trustees to be an organisation which has permanency, such as the Parish Council. A request was made that Culgaith Parish Council became the Holding Trustee of the Culgaith Village Hall (Victoria Institute).

Action: - Agreed that the Parish Council would consider this request, taking legal advice before making a decision.

- **Bush Impeding Vision.** It was reported that a bush, by the entrance to the Culgaith Recycling facility, was impeding vision when vehicles were leaving the site, creating a road hazard.

Action; - Following discussion a unanimous decision was made to arrange for the offending bush to be removed.
