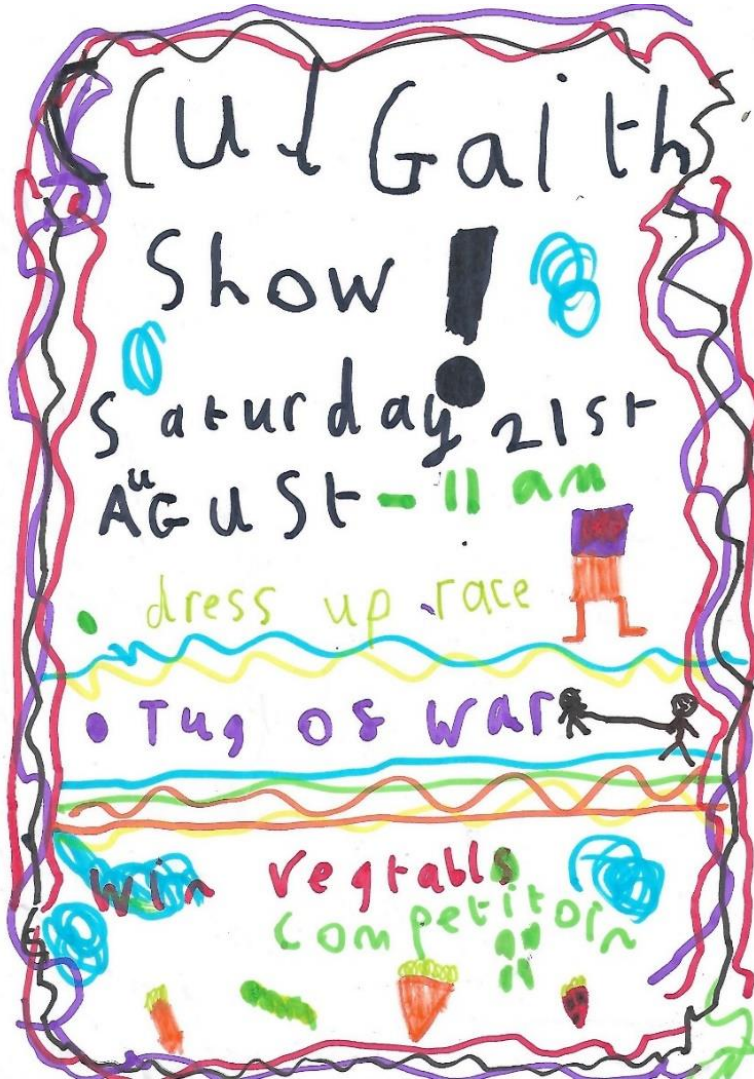

RULES & GUIDANCE

COVID-19

A Covid-19 Risk Assessment will be undertaken prior to the event and therefore some risk management measures may be in place (e.g. limiting numbers in the show tent). It is recommended all participants take an LFT test on the morning of the show.

SHOW ELIGIBILITY:

Open to anyone who lives in Culgaith Parish Council (the villages of Blencarn, Culgaith, Skirwith and Kirkland), people who work in the parish, attendees of the Culgaith art group and all children attending Culgaith School or Rainbows, Brownies or Guides.

HOW TO ENTER:

5k fun run (fancy dress optional!)

Turn up on the day and register **by 10.45am**. This is a fun run so please do dress up! The run will start and end at the Rec Ground and go around the village.

Sports Day

Turn up on the day and register **by 1.15pm**.

Show: Select categories and complete the entry form and return it together with your entry fees by Wednesday 18th August.

RULES:

Please read the rules carefully, in fairness to all they shall be strictly enforced.

- All entries to the show cost 25p each. Children's entries to the show are **FREE**.
- All entries to the Sports Day cost £2.
- Entries are limited to 3 per person per category.
- Exhibits must not have been previously shown at the show.
- Photographs in the Photography Section must have been taken by you. Exhibits must not be mounted or have been previously shown in our show. Photographs must not exceed 7"x5" (18cm x 13cm) in size and must have your exhibitor number on the back.
- All entries in the children's section must have been made or grown exclusively by the exhibitor.
- All exhibits must clearly show the exhibitor's number.
- All entries to be in tent at the Recreation Ground by 12pm on the day of the show, after which no exhibit will be accepted.
- The judges' decision is final.
- The show will close by 4pm before which time nothing shall be removed.
