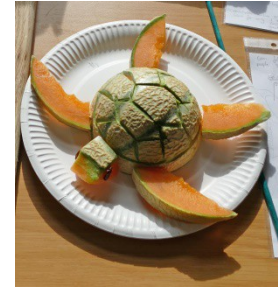


CULGAITH 39TH VILLAGE SHOW SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 2ND 2018

RULES

How to Enter

Select categories and complete the entry form and return it together with your entry fees by 30th August.

You can hand in your entry fees and form at:

The VIC (14:00-16:00) on August 23rd and August 30th

Or to Roger Leech Ivy House, Culgaith by August 30th

Please read the rules carefully, in fairness to all they shall be strictly enforced.

- Exhibitors are limited to residents of Culgaith, people who work in the village, attendees of the art group and all children attending Culgaith School or Rainbows, Brownies or Guides.
- All entries cost 25p each. Children's entries are FREE.
- Entries are limited to 3 per person per class.
- Exhibits MUST NOT have been previously shown at the show.
- Photographs in the Photography Section must have been taken by you. Exhibits MUST NOT be mounted or have been previously shown in our show. Photographs must not exceed 7"x5" (18cm x 13cm) in size and must have your exhibitor number on the BACK.
- All entries in the children's section must have been made or grown exclusively by the exhibitor.
- All exhibits must clearly show the exhibitor's number.
- All entries to be in the village hall by 10:30 on the morning of the show, after which no exhibit will be accepted.
- The show will close by 16:00 before which time nothing shall be removed.

Prize money for adults: 1st=75p, 2nd=50p, 3rd=25p

Prize money for under 14s: 1st=£2.50, 2nd=£1.50, 3rd=£1

CHILDREN can collect their prize money at the show.

ADULT PRIZE MONEY will be paid out during the week after the show by the committee (if not donated to the Air Ambulance).
